The Public Safety Commission met in Austin, Texas on January 10, 2007. Attending the meeting were Chairman Ernest Angelo, Jr., and Commissioner Louis E. Sturns.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Angelo. Proper notice had been posted.

- Minutes. Upon motion by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo, the minutes of the November 15, 2006 meeting were approved.
- II. Public comment. There was no public comment.
- III. Discharge appeal hearing of DPS employee Debra Arntfield. The Chairman announced that the hearing had been postponed to a later date.
- IV. Budget matters. Oscar Ybarra briefed the Commission on the DPS waiver request for capital and FTE limit reductions. There was some discussion on HUB percentages.
 - A. Acceptance of donation by Round Rock Police Department of night-vision device, valued at \$10,000.00. Colonel Davis briefed the Commission on the proposed gift. A motion was made by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo accepting the proposed donation.

- B. Acceptance of donation by San Antonio HIDTA of 2007 Ford truck, valued at \$53,275.00. Kent Mawyer briefed the Commission on the proposed gift. A motion was made by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo accepting the proposed donation.
- C. Approval of seized fund purchases. Colonel Davis briefed the Commission on the proposed purchases using seized funds. A motion was made by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo approving the attached seized fund purchases.
- V. Audit & Inspection report. Farrell Walker gave the audit & inspection report.
- VI. Division reports. Burt Christian gave the Administration Division report, including an update on livescan deployment, CHL processing backlog, upcoming recruit school, fleet vehicle production and the building program. The Texas Highway Patrol Division report was given by Randy Elliston. There was some discussion on a recent trooper injury, 2006 STEP results and ongoing THP drug and criminal interdiction efforts. Judy Brown gave the Driver License Division report, including an update on the driver license reengineering project, proposed legislation regarding driver license issues and the Real ID fiscal impact. The Driver Responsibility Program update was given by Judy Brown. The Emergency Management Division report, including an update of recent disaster declarations, ongoing drought operations, critical incident response training and Rio Grande operations, was given by Jack Colley. There was some discussion on the border security camera test project. The Criminal Law Enforcement Division report, including ongoing activities of the various services, was given by Kent Mawyer. Ray Coffman gave the Ranger Division report. The Information Management Service report was given by Ed Kelly.

VII. For publication for public comment.

A. Proposed amendment to Rule 16.100, 37 TAC Sec. 16.100, relating to Sanctions and Disqualifications to be reported on Commercial Driver Licenses as a result of traffic convictions. Bob Burroughs briefed the Commission on the proposed amendment. A motion was made by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo approving the attached amendment for publication for public comment.

Special Texas Ranger commissions had been considered for DPS retirees Ricardo Alvarado, Warren Donaway, Foy Goldston, Marcial Gonzalez, Don Graham, Roberto Loza, Ronnie Porter, Mark Riordan, Joe Roberts and Michael Tandy and a Special Texas Ranger commission was considered for DPS retiree Billy D. Davis. Also considered was the renewal of all current Special Ranger and Special Texas Ranger commissions. Upon motion by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo, Special Ranger and Special Texas Ranger commissions were approved for the above named individuals respectively and all current Special Ranger and Special Texas Ranger commissions were renewed for a 2 year period beginning January 1, 2007. A list of the Special Ranger and Special Texas Rangers approved for renewal is attached.

On January 10, 2007, the Public Safety Commission (Commission) by majority vote approved rules concerning:

Commercial Vehicle Regulations and Enforcement Procedures
Title 37 T.A.C. Part I, Chapter 4
Subchapter E
Section Number 4.71

The Texas Department of Public Safety adopts new Subchapter E, Section 4.71, concerning the Advisory Oversight Community Outreach Committee, without changes to the proposed text as published in the November 10, 2006, issue of the Texas Register (31 TexReg 9268).

Adoption of new Section 4.71 is necessary in order to establish the Advisory Oversight Community Outreach Committee in accordance with House Bill 925 (79th Texas Legislature—Regular Session). The purpose of the Advisory Oversight Community Outreach Committee is to document to the Public Safety Commission trade-related incidents involving department personnel; to develop recommendations and strategies to improve community relations, department personnel conduct, and the truck inspection process at the ports-of-entry on the Texas-Mexico border; and to act as ombudsman between the department and the residents and communities in the Texas-Mexico border area and between the department and the department's personnel.

No comments were received regarding adoption of the new section.

The new section is adopted pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 411.004(3), which authorizes the Public Safety Commission to adopt rules considered necessary for carrying out the department's work; and Texas Government Code, Section 411.0197(a), which authorizes the Public Safety Commission to adopt rules for the implementation and operation of the Advisory Oversight Community Outreach Committee.

Section Number 35.34

The Texas Department of Public Safety adopts amendments to Section 35.34, concerning Standards of Conduct, without changes to the proposed text as published in the November 10, 2006, issue of the Texas Register (31 TexReg 9270).

Adoption of the amendments to Section 35.34 are necessary in order to delete current subsection (a) which the department believes needlessly involves the Private Security Bureau in contractual disputes between licensees and clients; reformats the remaining sections and add a new subsection (n) which provides for additional standards of conduct for regulated businesses.

The Texas Department of Public Safety adopts amendments to Section 35.41, concerning Company Name Selection, without changes to the proposed text as published in the November 10, 2006, issue of the Texas Register (31 TexReg 9271).

Adoption of the amendments to Section 35.41 are necessary in order to add new subsections (b) and (c) which clarify the criteria used by the Bureau in evaluating company name requests and to reduce the confusion that occurs when substantially similar company names are used by unrelated entities. In addition, the title of the section has also been changed.

The Texas Department of Public Safety adopts amendments to Section 35.205, concerning Records Required on Commissioned Security Officers, without changes to the proposed text as published in the November 10, 2006, issue of the Texas Register (31 TexReg 9272).

Adoption of the amendments to Section 35.205 are necessary in order to shift the burden from the employer to the officer/employee, to ensure the accuracy of the employer's record of the officer's current residence. The amendment acknowledges that employers do not have independent information on their employees in this regard and must rely on what the employee provides to them.
