The Public Safety Commission met in Austin, Texas on November 15, 2006. Attending the meeting were Chairman Ernest Angelo, Jr., and Commissioner Louis E. Sturns.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Angelo. Proper notice had been posted.

- I. Minutes. Upon motion by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo, the minutes of the October 18, 2006 meeting were approved.
- **II.** Public comment. There was no public comment.
- III. Discharge appeal hearing of DPS employee Keith Ferguson. Phil Adkins, attorney representing DPS, advised he had been contacted by Mr. Ferguson the previous evening advising he chose to withdraw his appeal. A motion was made by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo affirming the discharge of Keith Ferguson (see attached order).
- IV. Budget matters. Oscar Ybarra updated the Commission on gasoline prices and current vacancies.

- V. Audit & Inspection report. Farrell Walker gave the audit & inspection report. There was some discussion on the annual report submitted to the State Auditor.
- VI. Division reports. Burt Christian gave the Administration Division report, including an update on livescan deployment, electronic arrest and disposition reporting, CHL processing backlog, fleet vehicle production and the building program. The Texas Highway Patrol Division report was given by Randy Elliston. There was some discussion on the recent awards presented by the Midlothian Police Department and DPS to area troopers and THP drug and criminal interdiction efforts. Greg Gloria gave the Driver License Division report, including an update on the driver license reengineering project, preliminary crash data and identity theft investigations by the fraud unit. The Driver Responsibility Program update was given by Greg Gloria. Russ Lecklider gave the Emergency Management Division report advising that a federal disaster declaration had been requested for the Southeast Texas flooding incident. The Criminal Law Enforcement Division report, including enforcement of 8 liner and illegal casino operating in Texas and increased use of CODIS and DNA for crime solving, was given by Gary Ray Coffman gave the Ranger Division report. The Information Management Stone. Service report was given by Ed Kelly. Chief Kelly gave an update on the TLETS reengineering project.
- VII. Personnel matters, pending and contemplated litigation, ongoing criminal investigations, status of purchase of real property. The Commission went into Executive Session pursuant to Tex. Gov. Code Secs. 551.071, 551.074, 551.072 & 411.0041 to discuss personnel matters, including the Director's action of discharging probationary employees Jessica Alpem and Christina Salazar; pending and contemplated litigation; status of purchase of real property; and ongoing criminal investigations. Upon reconvening Regular Session, Commissioner Angelo announced that the Commission had discussed personnel matters, pending litigation and ongoing criminal investigations. Upon motion by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo, the Director's action of discharging probationary employees Jessica Alpern and Christina Salazar was affirmed (see attached Order). A Special Texas Ranger commission had been considered for Douglas Hutchison of the Texas & Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association. A motion was made by Commissioner Sturns and seconded by Commissioner Angelo approving Douglas Hutchison as a Special Texas Ranger.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
